Guidelines for Events:

Video & Poster Presentation:

- The length of the video should not exceed 5 minutes and group contains maximum 3 members.
- The video should contains awarness, theme, solution relavent to the topic.
- ➤ The hard copy of poster can be kept in an A4 puch for display.
- The video must not contain material that is defamatory, offensive or encourages conduct that would be considered . Videos must be appropriate for viewing by the general public and by a multi-cultural international community.

Slogans on children safety:

- Appropriate slogan which could be fixed in an A4 size.
- ➤ The hardcopy can be kept in an A4 Pouch for the Display.
- **Font Style-**Times New Roman.
- ➤ **Font Size** The size with which the slogan fix with Visibility in the A4 Size.



Drama/Miming:


- ➤ Drama performances must be between 5 and 8 minutes in duration.
- Simple costumes are permitted and up to chairs and table will be made available at the venue if needed.

Drama scripts should be formatted in Word on A4 size paper with a standard font.



Model Making:

➤ The conceptual solutions shall be submitted as a model by an individual / group of maximum 4 members.



Elocution on child safety:

- ➤ The speech must be 5 minutes in length.
- The speech can be delivered as a word for word manuscript or in an extemporaneous manner using notes cards.
- The language is not a constraint.

Work of Art:

- Draw the selected design on a piece of paper
- Fill the design with colors, flowers, pulses or any other material.

Article Writing:

- Submissions must be a minimum of 500 words. There is no maximum word limit.
- ➤ The article should be created exclusively for the safety of children.
- The conclusion allows you to have the final say on the issues you have raised in your paper, to synthesize your thoughts, to demonstrate the importance of your ideas, and to propel your reader to a new view of the subject.
