### I. MoU between DSEC & NSKD Techno Research Innovation and Solution

A MoU was signed between DSEC and NSKD Techno Research Innovation and Solution to commence a range of 'IPR activities' for students and faculty at DSEC. Following the MoU signing ceremony, a Lecture Workshop on 'Patent Filing and Drafting at National and International Levels' was held on February 18, 2023, at the Mini Auditorium within the premises of Dhanalakshmi Srinivasan Group of Institutions in Perambalur - 621212.
